Required Documents and Materials

In order to submit a complete application, you will need to provide the following required documents and materials.

Academic Transcripts

Academic transcripts are required from all secondary schools attended. Applicants who are enrolled in or have completed degrees at institutions of higher education must submit official transcripts from those institutions.

Proof of English Language Proficiency

All applicants for whom English is not their first language must submit the results of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the Academic International English Language Testing System (Academic IELTS).

Biometric Photo

Submit a biometric, passport-sized photo of yourself. Passport photos should be $51 \ge 51 \mod (2 \ge 2 \pmod{2})$ inches). Please choose a color photo with a neutral or white background, with your head facing the camera and your face in full view.

Copy of Passport

Upload a digital photo or color scan of the front page of your passport(s) showing name, birth date, birth city and country, and citizenship information.

Pre-Screening Materials

Applicants must submit links to video recordings of the required pre-screening materials. For specific requirements per instrument, composition, and conducting – as well as details and helpful tips on creating your video links – please visit the Admissions page of the Barenboim-Said Akademie website.



Optional Documents and Materials

The following documents and materials are optional additions to your application. While we recommend you submit any that are relevant to you, these materials are not required.

Additional Test Scores

Applicants who wish to do so may upload recent test results from the SAT I or II or other relevant standardized tests.

Letters of Recommendation

Applicants are welcome to submit letters of recommendation from secondary school instructors, their music teachers, or other music professionals about their skills and qualifications. Letters may be submitted in any language, however if a letter is in a language other than English the applicant must also include an official English translation alongside the original.

Diplomas

Applicants who have already completed high school may upload a copy of their high school diploma. Applicants who have already received degrees from institutions of higher learning may also submit those diplomas. International Baccalaureate or language certificates are also welcome. Please note that while it is optional to include copies of your diplomas, transcripts are required from all secondary schools and institutions of higher-learning attended.

Curriculum Vitae

Applicants who wish to do so may upload a one- to two-page Curriculum Vitae that summarizes their musical experience, including recent performances, ensemble affiliations, special recognitions or prizes, and any additional training (such as participation in masterclasses or summer programs).

Auditions

Auditions at the Barenboim-Said Akademie are by invitation only. Complete applications will be carefully reviewed, and applicants will be informed by mid-March 2017 about the status of their applications. Selected applicants will be invited to audition and interview for faculty in Berlin in Spring 2017.

Audition dates are scheduled by instrument and faculty availability; applicants who are unable to attend their given audition date will have the opportunity to reschedule. Please note that the Barenboim-Said Akademie does not offer auditions to conducting applicants.

Audition dates for entry in the 2017-18 academic year are scheduled between the periods of 19 - 28 April 2017 and 15 - 19 May 2017.
