FACTS AND FIGURES Barenboim-Said Akademie

Building Both the Hall and the Academy are housed in the former

storage building of the Staatsoper Unter den Linden (Berlin State Opera) on Französischer Straße in the heart of Berlin, between the Staatsoper theatre and the Federal Foreign Office building. Designed by architect Richard Paulick, the building was erected between 1951 and 1955 to store the sets of the

Staatsoper, and is now a designated landmark building.

Financing The Federal Government of Germany is supporting the venture

by underwriting construction costs to the amount of 21,4 million euros and by providing subsidies for the operational budget. The remaining budget, however, is to be covered by private donations. The Alfried Krupp von Bohlen and the Halbach-Stiftung support the Edward-Said chair. The Stiftung Deutsche Klassenlotterie Berlin has made half a Million of equipment possible. The City of Berlin and the Stiftung Oper in Berlin have awarded the Barenboim-Said Academy a 99-year

leasehold contract for the listed building.

Curriculum The Barenboim-Said Akademie offers a conservatory

education for talented, young musicians from the Middle East, North Africa, and around the world, uniting music

performance studies with a grounding in the humanities.

The Akademie offers two degree programs: a four-year accredited Bachelor of Music degree and a one- to two-year

post-graduate Artist Diploma.

Student Body

The Barenboim-Said Akademie currently has 37 students

enrolled in either the Bachelor of Music of Artist Diploma program. The Akademie is funded to teach approximately 90

students.

Faculty at the Barenboim-Said Akademie includes professors

and lecturers in instrumental instruction, chamber music coaching, composition, musicology, music theory, philosophy, German, history, literature, writing, and physiotherapy. For the 2016-17 academic year, the Akademie plans to appoint nine

professors.
